Let someone go ahead of you in line.

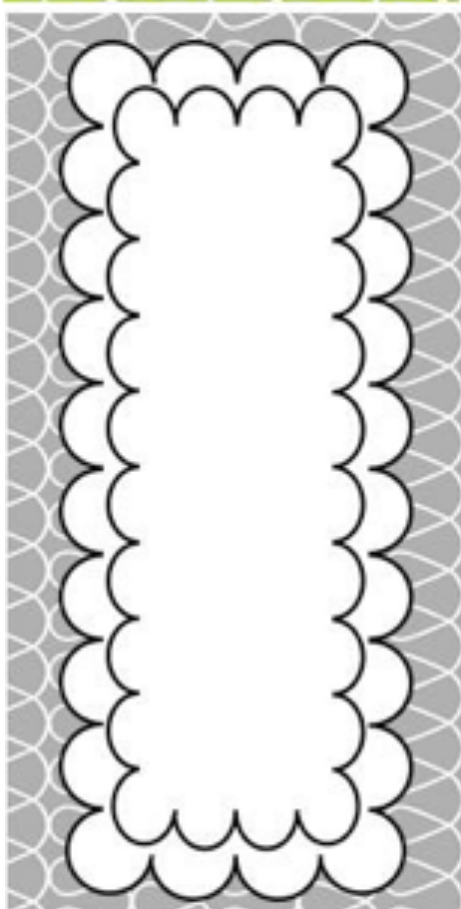
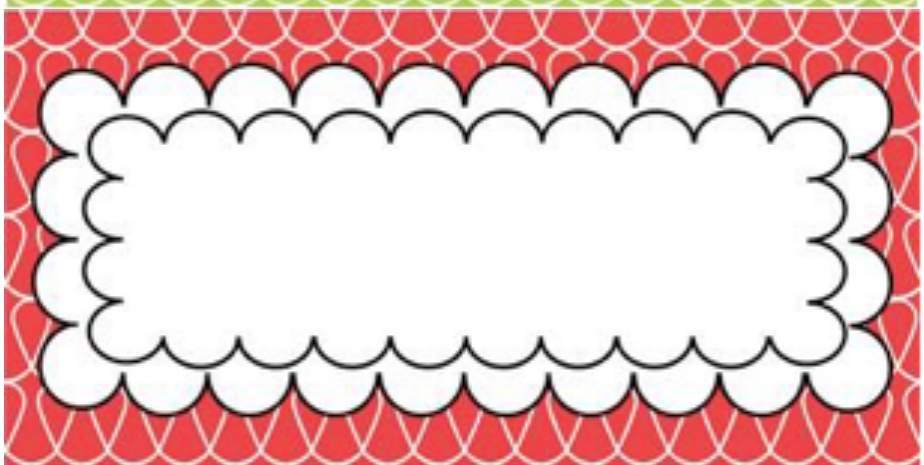
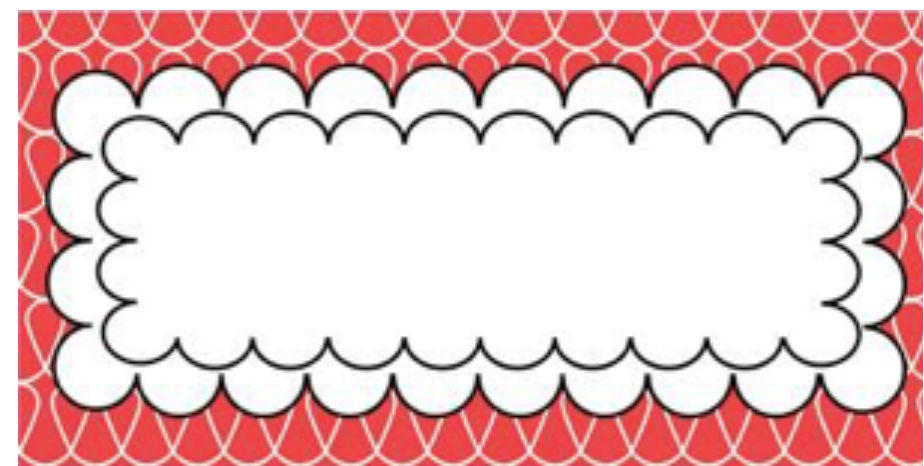
Call your grandparents and ask them a question about their childhood.
